THE LAND CUSTODY AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY  
(REVOCATION) ORDER, 2020

(Made under section 11(1))

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 11(1) of the Land Custody and Development Authority Ordinance, 1981 [*Ord. No. 4/81*], the Minister for Urban Development and Natural Resources has made the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the **Land Custody and Development Authority (Revocation) Order, 2020**, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of September, 2010.

**Cessation of Development Area in Sibul Division**

2. All that area of land described in the Schedule, being Development Area constituted under *Gazette* Notification No. Swk. L.N. 28 dated 15<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1986, by the Land Custody and Development Authority (Upper Lanang

Development Area) Order, 1986, shall cease to be a Development Area for the purpose of the Ordinance.

### **Revocation**

3. The Land and Custody Development Authority (Upper Lanang Development Area) Order, 1986 [*Swk. L.N. 28/1986*], is hereby revoked.

### *SCHEDULE*
