

THE SARAWAK RIVERS ORDINANCE, 1993
THE SARAWAK RIVERS (EXEMPTION OF VESSELS)
ORDER, 1993

[Swk. L.N. 131/93]

(Made under section 35 (3))

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 35(3) of the Sarawak Rivers Ordinance, 1993 [Cap. 4], the Minister for Infrastructure Development has made the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the **Sarawak Rivers (Exemption of Vessels) Order, 1993**, and shall come into force on the 1st day of November, 1993.

Exemption

2. The vessels described in column (1) of the Schedule shall be exempted from those provisions of the Sarawak Rivers Ordinance, 1993, specified in column (2), and from the provisions of the Sarawak Rivers (Traffic) Regulations, 1993, specified in the corresponding column (3).

(2) All vessels of the Navy of a friendly nation on goodwill visit and such other vessels of a foreign government whose entry into Sarawak waters is approved by the Federal Government.	-do-	-do-
(3) All local fishing vessels (as defined in the Fisheries Act, 1985 [Act 317]) and all foreign fishing vessels (as defined in the said Act) which are permitted to enter Malaysian fisheries waters under section 16(1) of the Act.	-do-	The whole of Part V.
(4) Any foreign vessel or Malay-sian registered ship entering any river for the purposes of calling in Bintulu Port or any port within the jurisdiction of any port authority constituted under the Port Authorities Ordinance of Sarawak.	-do-	Regulation 20(1) and the whole of Part V.
