

THE STATE ROADS ORDINANCE, 1994

**THE STATE ROADS (TUN DATUK PATINGGI ABANG MOHAMMED
SALAHUDDIN BRIDGE) (TOLLS) ORDER, 2003**

[Swk. L.N. 102/2003]

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6(2) of the State Roads Ordinance, 1994 [*Cap. 9*], the Director of Public Works has, with the approval of the Minister of Infrastructure Development and Communications, made the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the **State Roads (Tun Datuk Patinggi Abang Mohammed Salahuddin Bridge) (Tolls) Order, 2003**, and shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 2003.

Authority to collect toll

2. As from this date, Zalpoint Corporation Sdn. Bhd. (Co. No. 445082-T) with a registered address at 4th Floor, Menara Zecon, No. 92, Lot 393 Section 5, KTL D, Jalan Satok, 93400 Kuching ("Zalpoint") may collect from vehicles of the class and description referred to in the first column of the Schedule, crossing or using the Tun Datuk Patinggi Abang Mohammed Salahuddin Bridge across Sungai Sarawak, Kuching ("the Bridge"), tolls specified in the second column and Zalpoint shall be entitled to retain all tolls so collected.

Liability for toll

3. It shall be the responsibility of the drivers to pay to Zalpoint the tolls chargeable under this Order on their vehicles.

Place where tolls are to be collected

4. Zalpoint shall collect such tolls at place(s) on the access roads to the Bridge designated by the Director.

Exemptions

5.—(1) All pedestrians and passengers of vehicles, non-mechanical vehicles, ambulances and vehicles belonging to the Royal Malaysia Police, Civil Defence, Fire and Rescue Services, shall be exempted from the payment of any tolls when crossing or using the Bridge.

(2) Motorcycles shall be exempted from payment of tolls for a period of one year from date of commencement of this Order, and thereafter, motorcycles shall be charged toll at the rate shown in the Schedule.

(3) Any vehicles specifically exempted by Zalpoint, with the approval of the Minister, from payment of tolls.

Motor car, including taxi and 4 wheel-drive vehicle	RM1.50
Van or pick up	RM2.00
Bus or coach	RM3.00
Lorry, truck and trailer	RM3.00
Motorcycle	RM0.50
