THE PORT AUTHORITIES ORDINANCE, 1961

THE RAJANG PORT AUTHORITY (COMPOUNDING OF OFFENCES)
REGULATIONS, 2003

(Made under section 64(1)(i))

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 64(1)(i) of the Port Authorities Ordinance, 1961 [*Ord. No. 1/61*], the Rajang Port Authority has, with the approval of the Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, made the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the **Rajang Port Authority (Compounding of Offences) Regulations, 2003**, and shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 2004.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations

“Authority” means the Rajang Port Authority established pursuant to Part II of the Ordinance;

“General Manager” means the General Manager of the Rajang Port Authority appointed under section 54 of the Ordinance;

“Ordinance” means the Port Authorities Ordinance, 1961 [*Ord. No. 1/61*].

Compoundable offences

3. The following offences are prescribed as offences which may be compounded by the General Manager or any other officer authorized in writing by him, by notification in the *Gazette*, pursuant to section 53A of the Ordinance:

- (a) any offence under sections 12E, 53B, 59, 60 and 61 of the Ordinance; and
- (b) offences under such regulations, by-laws or orders made pursuant to the Ordinance.

Offer to compound

4.—(1) Where the General Manager or a duly authorized officer decides to compound an offence, he shall send or cause to be sent to or personally serve or cause to be personally served on the person reasonably suspected of having committed the offence an offer to compound as in Form I in the Schedule, which may be modified as necessary.

(2) The offer shall state the sum for which the offence will be compounded and the date by which the sum must be paid.

Sum to be collected and mode of payment

5.—(1) The sum of money to be collected for compounding an offence shall not exceed fifty per centum (50%) of the maximum fine prescribed for the offence as specified under section 53A of the Ordinance.

(2) All moneys for payment of the compound shall be made in cash, or by cheque, money order, postal order, cashier’s order, banker’s order or bank draft made payable to the Rajang Port Authority and crossed “Account Payee Only”.

(3) Payment may be delivered personally to the authorized person making the offer to compound, but, if sent by post, must be addressed to the General Manager, Rajang Port Authority, Jalan Pulau, 96000 Sibul, Sarawak, together with the form for payment in Form II in the Schedule.

(4) Every payment received must be accounted for as money belonging to the Authority and an official receipt for the payment as in Form III in the Schedule shall be issued to the person to whom the offer to compound was made.

(5) Notwithstanding regulation 4(2), the General Manager or the duly authorized officer may accept in composition any sum of the correct amount paid later than the time or period allowed in the offer to compound.

Prosecution of offence

6. Where the amount of the compound fee payable in the offer to compound is not paid within the period specified or any extension thereof, prosecution for the offence may be instituted against the offender without further notice.
